Respondent further acknowledges that he has been represented by legal counsel throughout these proceedings, or has been advised of his right to be represented by legal counsel, which right he hereby waives. Respondent neither admits nor denies the allegations set forth in this Order.

- 3. Respondent has agreed to informal disposition of this matter without a hearing as provided under Minn. Stat. § 14.59 (2000) and Minn. R. 1400.5900 (1999).
 - 4. The following Order is in the public interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that Respondent's insurance agents license is revoked.
