CONSENT CEASE AND DESIST ORDER

Commissioner of Commerce Glenn Wilson (hereinafter "Commissioner") has determined as follows:

- 3. The Commissioner has advised Jacksons Stop, Inc. (hereinafter "Respondent") that he is prepared to commence formal action pursuant to Minn. Stat. §§ 45.027, subd. 5 (2004) and §325D.71 (2004), against Respondent based on allegations that Respondent, during the months of June and July 2004 engaged in the continuing offer and sale of gasoline below the minimum allowable price, in violation of Minn. Stat. §325D.04 (2004).
- 2. Respondent acknowledges that it has been advised of its rights to a hearing in this matter, to present argument to the Commissioner and to appeal from any adverse determination after a hearing, and Respondent hereby expressly waives those rights. Respondent further acknowledges that it has been represented by legal counsel throughout these proceedings, or has been advised of its right to be represented by legal counsel which right it hereby waives.
- 3. Respondent has agreed to informal disposition of this matter without a hearing as provided under Minn. Stat. § 14.59 (2004) and Minn. R. 1400.5900 (2000), and without acknowledging that the alleged violations have occurred.
 - 4. The following Order is in the public interest.

CONSENT TO ENTRY OF ORDER

The undersigned, acting on behalf of Jacksons Stop, Inc., (hereinafter known as "Respondent") states that Respondent has read the foregoing Consent Order; that Respondent knows and fully understands its contents and effect; that Respondent is authorized to execute this Consent to Entry of Order on behalf of Respondent; that Respondent has been advised of Respondent's right to a hearing; that Respondent has been represented by legal counsel in this matter; or that Respondent has been advised of Respondent's right to be represented by legal counsel and that Respondent has waived this right; and that Respondent consents to entry of this Order by the Commissioner of Commerce. It is further expressly understood that this Order constitutes the entire settlement agreement between the parties hereto, there being no other promises or agreements, either express or implied.
