**CONSENT ORDER**

Commissioner of Commerce Glenn Wilson (hereinafter "Commissioner") has determined as follows:

1. The Commissioner has advised Lawrence Bruce Beck (hereinafter "Respondent") that he is prepared to commence formal action pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 82B.07 (2004) against Respondent's Licensed Real Property appraiser's license based on allegations that Respondent:
  - A. Provided false, misleading, or incomplete information in violation of Minn. Stat. § 45.027, Subd. 7 (3) (2004);
  - B. Failed to provide evidence satisfactory to the Commissioner of having met the continuing education requirements of Minn. Stat. § 82B.19 (2004) and;
2. Respondent acknowledges that he has been advised of his rights to a hearing in this matter, to present argument to the Commissioner and to appeal from any adverse determination at a hearing, and Respondent hereby expressly waives those rights. Respondent further acknowledges that he has been represented by legal counsel throughout these proceedings, or has been advised of his right to be represented by legal counsel, which right he hereby waives.
3. Respondent has agreed to informal disposition of this matter without a hearing as provided under Minn. Stat. § 14.59 (2004) and Minn. R. 1400.5900 (2003).
4. The following Order is in the public interest.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED**, that the Licensed Real Property Appraiser License of Lawrence Bruce Beck is suspended for one week commencing April 17, 2006 through and including April 23, 2006.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Respondent complete 15 hours of qualified appraiser training and provide evidence satisfactory to the Commissioner of having completed said hours on or before May 22, 2006.



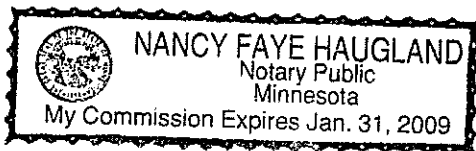
