CONSENT ORDER

In the Matter of the Certified Residential Real Property Appraiser License of Constance Lindblade Ferguson License No. AP20319007

Commissioner of Commerce Glenn Wilson (hereinafter "Commissioner") has determined as follows:

- 1. The Commissioner has advised Constance Lindblade Ferguson (hereinafter "Respondent") that he is prepared to commence formal action pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 82B.07 (2004) against Respondent's Certified Residential Real Property appraiser's license based on allegations that Respondent:
  - A. Provided false, misleading, or incomplete information in violation of Minn. Stat. § 45.027, Subd. 7 (3) (2004);
  - B. Failed to provide evidence satisfactory to the Commissioner of having met the continuing education requirements of Minn. Stat. § 82B.19 (2004) and;
- 2. Respondent acknowledges that she has been advised of her rights to a hearing in this matter, to present argument to the Commissioner and to appeal from any adverse determination at a hearing, and Respondent hereby expressly waives those rights. Respondent further acknowledges that she has been represented by legal counsel throughout these proceedings, or has been advised of her right to be represented by legal counsel, which right she hereby waives.
- 3. Respondent has agreed to informal disposition of this matter without a hearing as provided under Minn. Stat. § 14.59 (2004) and Minn. R. 1400.5900 (2003).

4. The following Order is in the public interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 45.027 Subd. 7 (2004) Constance Lindblade Ferguson is censured.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent complete 7.5 hours of qualified appraiser training and provide evidence satisfactory to the Commissioner of having completed said hours on or before April 17, 2006.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 45.027, subd. 6 (2004), as amended, Respondent shall pay to the State of Minnesota a civil penalty of \$500.

This Order shall be effective upon signature by or on behalf of the Commissioner.
